Grinch Cheesecake Lush

Let's go shopping!

36 vanilla oreo cookies
6 Tbsp melted butter
8 oz softened cream cheese
1 cup powdered sugar
16 oz cool whip
2 boxes 3.4 oz vanilla instant
pudding
2 1/2 cups cold milk
1 tsp peppermint extract
Green and red food coloring
Green heart sprinkles



Now for the fun part

- 1. Separate your cookies from the cream center. It won't be needed. Then in a food processor or baggie, crush the cookies.
- 2. Place cookie crumbs in a large bowl and add melted butter. Stir until well blended.
- 3. Press the cookie mixture in a glass 9x13 baking dish.
- 4. Grab your mixer and combine powdered sugar and cream cheese, once smooth, fold in cool whip:
- 5. Add the green coloring until you've got the right shade you want
- 6. Spread that mixture over the cookie mixture.
- 7. In a medium bowl, whisk pudding and milk until combined. Add peppermint and red coloring.
- 8. Spread over the cream cheese.
- 9. Mix the remaining cool whip with the green coloring. Try to match the green used before.
- 10. Spread that mixture on top.
- 11. Put your sprinkles over the top and refrigerate for 4 hours.
- 12 Now it's time to show off your creation.
